However, you play a part in natural gas safety too. You can use your eyes, ears and nose to stay alert to potential dangers.

Recognizing a Natural Gas Leak

LOOK – Do you see dirt blowing in the air near a natural gas pipeline? This could be a sign of a natural gas pipeline leak.

LISTEN – Listen for a hissing or roaring sound. This may be an indication of a natural gas pipeline leak.

SMELL – An additive, mercaptan, is used to give natural gas its very distinct odor – rotten eggs. This pungent smell is a warning sign of a possible natural gas pipeline leak.

CALL – If you suspect a natural gas pipeline leak, leave the area immediately and call 1-888-NM-GAS-CO (1-888-664-2726).

THE COST OF GAS

As a regulated utility, New Mexico Gas Company does not make a profit on the natural gas we purchase on behalf of our customers but passes the cost of natural gas from suppliers directly on to you. November's cost of gas is \$0.3042. The December cost of gas can be found as a line item on your bill beginning December 1st. Last December's cost of gas was \$0.3535. The estimated average home gas use for December is 123 therms and the estimated average residential gas bill for December is \$86.
