## LOW ODORANT LEVELS DETECTED IN QUESTA SYSTEM

New Mexico Gas Company alerts the public to be aware of low odorant levels in natural gas in its distribution system in the Questa area.

**QUESTA, N.M.** – New Mexico Gas Company is experiencing a low odorant level in its pipelines in Questa and surrounding areas.

Under normal conditions, a natural gas leak will smell like rotten eggs. With low odorant levels, natural gas may have no smell. Therefore, until further notice, individuals in the affected area should not rely exclusively upon their sense of smell to detect the presence of natural gas.

To remedy the situation, crews will vent gas from a transmission pipeline in Red River and may need to vent gas from the distribution system in Questa. The pipelines then will be restored with natural gas that has been odorized to acceptable levels.

Under current conditions, it is especially important that the public be alert to other signs of a potential leak that include:

- Hissing or blowing sounds
- Standing water continuously bubbling
- Dirt or water blowing in the air
- Decay in vegetation

Individuals who are performing work on natural gas piping or installing natural gas appliances should not rely on smell to determine the presence of natural gas or leaks.
