NEW MEXICO GAS COMPANY PROVIDES FUNDING TO SUPPORT VOLUNTEER FIRST RESPONDERS

ALBUQUERQUE – New Mexico Gas Company has awarded \$228,000 to volunteer first responder organizations throughout New Mexico in the first round of grants under its Helping Heroes program. Awardees include:

- Elephant Butte Fire Department to provide community safety education including the distribution of carbon monoxide monitoring systems
- Mesilla Valley Search and Rescue to purchase multiple three-part lightweight titanium litter systems to aid in all-terrain rescues
- Carson Volunteer Fire Department to purchase extrication equipment
- Las Palomas Fire Department to purchase a drone that will aid in aerial monitoring
- Pinos Altos Fire Department to help purchase new Self-Contained Breathing Apparatuses
- Latir Volunteer Fire Department to expand a wildland fire training program
- La Cienega Fire and Rescue to purchase new Personal Protective Equipment for current and incoming volunteer first responders and
- Cochiti Fire Department to support the maintenance and replacement of wildland gear.

The Helping Heroes grant program provides financial assistance to volunteer first responder organizations in New Mexico communities served by NMGC.

"We recognize the vital role of volunteer first responders who dedicate their time and energy to protect our communities," said New Mexico Gas Company President Ryan Shell. "Their public safety commitment aligns with ours and our Helping Heroes program supports their important work."
