The Cost of Gas

As a regulated utility, New Mexico Gas Company does not make a profit on the natural gas we purchase on behalf of our customers but passes the cost of natural gas from suppliers directly on to you. December's cost of gas is \$0.3558. The January cost of gas can be found as a line item on your bill beginning January 1st. Last January's cost of gas was \$0.2694. The estimated average home gas use for January is 123 therms and the estimated average residential gas bill for January is \$89.
