RELIEF FOR FEDERAL EMPLOYEES DURING SHUTDOWN

NO WINTER DISCONNECTS FOR THOSE FURLOUGHED

ALBUQUERQUE – Federal employees who are working without pay or furloughed as a result of the federal government shutdown should call New Mexico Gas Company to discuss payment arrangements for their residential service and to inquire about other available assistance.

For those federal employees, disconnections for non-payment are being suspended for the winter heating season and they will not be charged late payment penalties. Affected federal employees can also call to learn about assistance programs that are offered to all customers.

Customers who are affected will need to verify their active federal employment status. This can be done by presenting a government employee photo identification, a badge or other documentation at any NMGC walk-in office or to an NMGC field collector.
